Project includes furnishing all labor and materials necessary for the installation of high density storage system in Burk Hall #19 approximately 1,502 sq.ft (vif). Contractor is to provide design, cut-sheets and other information to support the approval process of structural review, Fire Marshall and ADA compliance. Estimated value is \$55,000.00. Liquidated damages will be assessed at \$100.00 for each day completion is delayed beyond the time prescribed.

A 10% security in the form of cashier's check or bond is required with the proposal.

Additional requirements include a minimum 3% Disabled Veterans Business Enterprises participation or evidence of a Good Faith Effort to do so, Payment & Performance Bonds, payment of Prevailing Wages, Nondiscrimination in Employment and Fair Employment Practices. Advertising for DVBE participation is required unless the contractor attains the minimum 3% participation goal.

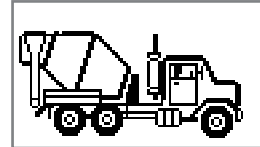

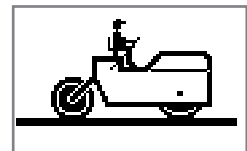
