Bidders' attention is directed to General Conditions Article GC9.7.1.1, which permits the substitution of securities by Contractor for any monies retained by the District to insure performance under this Contract.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bidder's Security equal to at least 10 percent of the total Bid Price, which shall remain in full force and effect for the period of time stated in the Instructions to Bidders, Paragraph 15.C, Time of Award. The Bidder's Security must be in the form of cash, a cashier's check, a certified check, a Bidder's Bond, or a combination thereof. The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded shall comply with the District's insurance requirements. Such Bidder shall furnish a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond (Payment Bond), each in an amount not less than 100 percent of the Contract Price. Bonds shall be on forms provided by the District and shall be executed as surety by a corporation or corporations authorized to issue surety bonds in the State of California, as an admitted surety insurer and acceptable to the District.

Bids will be received at the City of Grass Valley, Engineering Division, 125 E Main Street, Grass Valley, CA 95945 until **3:30 P.M. on August 12, 2008** at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud at said address. Any Protest regarding the award of the contract must be submitted pursuant to the instructions stated in the special provisions.

#### GENERAL WORK DESCRIPTION:

The work to be performed, in general, includes removing and disposing of approximately 80 linear feet of 18" diameter corrugated metal pipe and replacing it with 18" diameter HDPE pipe. Also associated with this work will be: miscellaneous demolition, clearing and grubbing; removing and replacing asphalt concrete pavement, PCC sidewalk, PCC driveway approach, and PCC curb and gutter; and installing a new drain inlet; and other related materials and labor necessary to complete the work per the Project Specifications and as shown on the Project drawings.

**Project Location:** The site is located at 928 Taylorville Road in Grass Valley, California. The Engineer's estimate for this project is **\$40,000.00**. No pre-bid meeting is scheduled for this project.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. The City of Grass Valley reserves the right to postpone the date and time for the opening of proposals at any time prior to the date and time announced in the advertisement in accordance with applicable law.

The City of Grass Valley reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any minor defect or irregularity in bidding in accordance with applicable law. In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20103.8, if the City elects to award a contract for perfor-

mance of the project, the contract will be awarded in accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20162 and other applicable law to the responsible bidder submitting a responsive bid with the lowest total bid price for the base bid without consideration of the bid price for any additive or deductive items. All bids will remain valid for 90 days after the bid opening. Except as permitted by law and subject to all applicable remedies, including forfeiture of bidder's security, bidders may not withdraw their bid during the 90 day period after the bid opening.

Attention is directed to the requirements specified in Section 7-1.01C, "Contractor's Licensing Laws", of the Standard Specifications. The Contractor shall possess a valid California Class "A" Contractor's License, or a combination of the following classes: C-8 Concrete Contractor, C-12 Earthwork and Paving Contractor, C-32 Parking and Highway Improvement, C-34 Pipeline Contractor, and D-63 Construction Cleanup Contractor, and all other classes required by the categories and types of work included in the contract at the time of the bid award. All licenses shall remain in effect throughout the term of the contract.

A non-refundable fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per bid set will be charged if picked up, or thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per bid set if mailed.

Bid Bonds shall be required for this project. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond and certificates of liability and property damage insurance. The amounts of liability and property damage insurance will not be less than the amounts shown in the Contract and shall also include the endorsements specified.

Bidders are urged to obtain DBE participation on this project, although there are no specific goals for DBE participation.

The City of Grass Valley hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

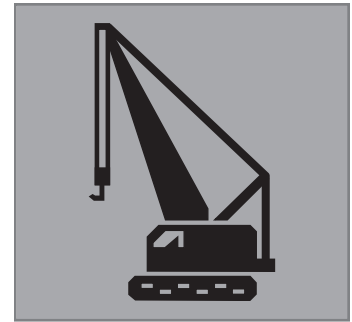
