In general, work consists of furnishing all labor and materials necessary to remove and replace various campus swing doors, frames, side and transom glazing panels and door hardware at the Administration, Creative Arts, Fine Arts, Gymnasium, Hensill Hall, Old Administration, Science and Thornton Hall buildings in accordance with plans and specifications provided by W.S.R. Architects, 70 Woodland Street, Suite A, San Francisco CA 94117. Attn: Will Revilock - Tel (415) 681-6504; FAX (415) 681-6541. Bidder must have a C-61 license with a D-28 door specialty. Estimated construction budget is \$140,000.00. Contract duration is 102 calendar days with liquidated damages assessed at \$700.00 for each day completion is delayed beyond the time prescribed. Installations to be scheduled between November 3rd to December 24th 2008 -and- January 2nd to Jan 18th 2009.

A mandatory pre-bid conference & site inspection is scheduled for 10:00 A.M., August 26, 2008. Interested bidders should assemble at the Work Control Center at Facilities & Service Enterprises in the Corporation Yard (on North State Drive). Parking is available in either Lot 20 or 25 at the rate of \$1.00 per hour (up to four hours) or \$5.00 per day.

Sealed bids are due before 2:00 P.M., September 9th 2008 in the Office of John Lew, Facilities & Service Enterprises, at San Francisco State University, 1600 Holloway Avenue, San Francisco CA 94132-4033 or they will be disregarded. It is the bidder's responsibility to insure their bid is delivered to Mr. Lew prior to the bid submittal deadline; the University assumes no responsibility for bids delivered late by the U.S. Postal Service or by any other means of delivery. A bidder's security of 10% of the bid amount is required with each bid.

Additional bid requirements include a minimum 3% Disabled Veterans Business Enterprises (D.V.B.E.) participation or evidence of a Good Faith Effort to do so, 100% Payment & Performance Bonds, payment of Prevailing Wages, Nondiscrimination in Employment and Fair Employment Practices. Advertising for D.V.B.E. participation is required unless the bidder attains the minimum participation goal.
