The Bidders Security must be in the form of cash, a cashiers check, a certified check, a Bidders Bond, or a combination thereof. The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded shall comply with the Districts insurance requirements. Such Bidder shall furnish a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond (Payment Bond), each in an amount not less than 100 percent of the Contract Price. Bonds shall be on forms provided by the District and shall be executed as surety by a corporation or corporations authorized to issue surety bonds in the State of California, as an admitted surety insurer and acceptable to the District.

Sealed bids for RADIAL GATE SEAL INSTALLATION (MINOR CONTRACT) CHOWCHILLA CANAL BYPASS CONTROL STRUCTURE, LOWER SAN JOAQUIN RIVER FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER RESTORATION PROGRAM, MADERA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 09-20, CONTRACT NO. Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Prepare existing steel radial gates, including:
  - a. Drilling bolt holes, b. Grinding and miscellaneous surface preparation for fit-up of new gate seal hardware.
2. Fabricate new gate seals, including:
  - a. Carbon steel guide angles, plate washers and bottom reinforcing plates, b. UHMW Polyethylene backing bars, c. Molded rubber bottom and side seals, d. Rubber gaskets.
3. Install new gate seals, including:
  - a. Welded installation of bottom reinforcing plates, b. Grinding new and existing bottom reinforcing plates for proper fit, c. Bolted installation of new rubber bottom and side seals, gaskets, guide angles and UHMW Polyethylene backing bars.
