Notice is hereby given that the Architecture & Engineering/Facilities Management Department on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, California, will receive sealed bids on or before 2:00 p.m. on December 22, 2009, in the office of the Architecture & Engineering/Facilities Management Department, 385 North Arrowhead Avenue, Third Floor, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0184, at which time they will be publicly opened and declared for Sheriffs Scientific Investigation Building Emergency Power Project in San Bernardino, California.

A mandatory Pre-bid Meeting for prospective bidders will be conducted on December 15, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. at 200 South Lena Road, San Bernardino. Bids submitted by firms who have not participated in the Pre-bid Meeting will be disqualified.

State Contractor's Class B or C-10 License is required to bid the project. If the bidder does **not** list a licensed subcontractor(s) under the Designation of Subcontractors section of the Bid Proposal to perform work in any of the following trades, in order to be found responsive and in order to perform that work himself/herself, the bidder must possess the State specialty license for that trade: Electrical (C-10). Construction estimate is \$70,000.

The Bid Documents, including final plans and specifications are available on electronic media (CD) at no cost to the bidder and may be obtained from the Architecture & Engineering/Facilities Management Department.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled bid opening, or within sixty (60) days thereafter.

Copies of the prevailing wage rates are on file at the Office of Architecture and Engineering/Facilities Management Department and shall be made available to any interested party on request. Copies are also included in the Bid Documents.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technical errors, discrepancies or informalities of a bid not affected by law, if to do so seems to best serve the public interest.
