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Project Description: The objective of the project is the construction of a 40 million gallon per day sedimentation and flocculation basin, modifications to existing flow distribution structure, upgrade of existing filters, and the construction of a new 17.5 million gallon Treated Water Reservoir. The Engineer's estimate: \$109M.
