Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Department of Fish and Game, Engineering Branch, 1812 9th Street, Ste. 100, Sacramento, California, 95811, until 2:00 p.m. March 10, 2010, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read for the work as follows:

Provide all labor, tools, equipment, materials, permits and taxes necessary to construct new metal building, new prefabricated concrete ADA compliant restroom, ADA parking and miscellaneous work at Darrah Springs Fish Hatchery, Paynes Creek, Shasta County, California.

License Required: A or B

Engineers Estimate: \$ 200,000.00

Prospective bidders may examine and obtain the bid forms, specifications, plans, and addenda (if any) by downloading this bid package from the Department of General Services (DGS) website at <http://www.eprocure.dgs.ca.gov/CSCRAAds.htm>. At the website on the left-hand side of the page under the SEARCH pane, enter the following Invitation for Bid Number: EA-902 and select the Search button. Select Description to view the full advertisement. Any discrepancies, omissions, ambiguities, or conflicts in or among the contract documents or doubts as to meaning shall be brought to the States attention by email to planroom@dfg.ca.gov or FAX to 916-327-6320 no later than 5 P.M., seven (7) calendar days prior to bid opening date.

It is the responsibility of the bidders to download any addendum as needed from DGS website address stated above.

Pursuant to Section 1770 of the Labor Code, the Department of Industrial Relations has ascertained the general prevailing wage rates to be as listed in the Prevailing Wage Data Base, located at www.dir.ca.gov, or is available for inspection by interested parties at the address shown above.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 10115 et seq., State law requires that contracts

have a participation goal of 3% for Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE's) for all contracts of \$10,000 or more. Bids will only be accepted from those bidders who certify that they have achieved the goal as outlined in the instructions with the bid forms.

To qualify for the DVBE Incentive Preference, the bidder must achieve a minimum DVBE participation goal of 3%.

The projects bid award is subject to the Small Business Procurement and Contract Act five (5) percent bid preference rules.

A bidder's bond of at least 10% of the bid amount shall be submitted with bids of \$5,000 and over.

For bid awards of \$5,000 and over; a 100% performance bond and 100% payment bond is required.
