Notice is hereby given that the Architecture & Engineering Department on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, California, will receive sealed bids on or before 2:00 p.m. on February 16, 2010, in the office of the Architecture & Engineering Department, 385 North Arrowhead Avenue, Third Floor, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0184, at which time they will be publicly opened and declared for the Demolition of Dilapidated Structures at the Barstow/Daggett Airport - Phase II in Daggett, California.

A mandatory Pre-bid Meeting for prospective bidders will be conducted on February 8, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. at the Airport Managers office on the Barstow/Daggett Airport located approximately 13 miles east of Barstow off Interstate 40 at 39500 National Trails Highway in Daggett, California. Bids submitted by firms who have not participated in the Pre-bid Meeting will be disqualified.

State Contractor's Class C-21 License is required. Construction estimate is \$100,000.

The Bid Documents, including final plans and specifications are available on electronic media (CD) at no cost to the bidder and may be obtained from the Architecture & Engineering Department.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled bid opening, or within sixty (60) days thereafter.

Copies of the prevailing wage rates are on file at the Office of Architecture and Engineering Department and shall be made available to any interested party on request. Copies are also included in the Bid Documents.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technical errors, discrepancies or informalities of a bid not affected by law, if to do so seems to best serve the public interest.
