General Work Description:

The bridge work to be done, in general, includes constructing a new bridge and road approaches; removing an existing bridge; grading; paving; placing rock slope protection; applying signing and striping, highway planting and erosion control, providing traffic control, and other items and details, not mentioned above, that are required by the plans, specifications or these Special Provisions for the bridge listed below.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein.

The engineers estimate for this project is **\$1,100,000**

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond.

The County of Placer affirms that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at County of Placer, 3091 County Center Drive, Community Development Resource Agency Building, Auburn, California 95603 or at the Office of the Purchasing Agent, County of Placer, 2964 Richardson Drive, DeWitt Center, Auburn, California 95603 and available from the California Department of

Industrial Relations Internet web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>. The Federal minimum wage rates for this project as predetermined by the United States Secretary of Labor are set forth in the Bid Book and in copies of this book that may be examined at the offices described above where project plans, special provisions, and bid forms may be seen. Addenda to modify the Federal minimum wage rates, if necessary, will be issued to holders of Bid Book. Future effective general prevailing wage rates, which have been predetermined and are on file with the California Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in the general prevailing wage rates.

Attention is directed to the Federal minimum wage rate requirements in the Bid Book. If there is a difference between the minimum wage rates predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and the general prevailing wage rates determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations for similar classifications of labor, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the higher wage rate. The Department will not accept lower State wage rates not specifically included in the Federal minimum wage determinations. This includes "helper" (or other classifications based on hours of experience) or any other classification not appearing in the Federal wage determinations. Where Federal wage determinations do not contain the State wage rate determination otherwise available for use by the Contractor and subcontractors, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the Federal minimum wage rate, which most closely approximates the duties of the employees in question.
