Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at County of Placer, 3091 County Center Drive, Community Development Resource Agency Building, Auburn, California 95603 or at the Office of the Purchasing Agent, County of Placer, 2964 Richardson Drive, DeWitt Center, Auburn, California 95603 and available from the California Department of Industrial Relations Internet web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>. The Department will not accept lower State wage rates not specifically included in the Federal minimum wage determinations. This includes "helper" (or other classifications based on hours of experience) or any other classification not appearing in the Federal wage determinations. Where Federal wage determinations do not contain the State wage rate determination otherwise available for use by the Contractor and subcontractors, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the Federal minimum wage rate, which most closely approximates the duties of the employees in question.
