Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Department of Fish and Game, Engineering Branch, 1812 9th Street, Ste. 100, Sacramento, California, 95811, until 2:00 p.m. **June 8, 2010** at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read for the work as follows:

Provide all labor, tools, equipment, materials, permits and taxes necessary to increase the dissolved oxygen in the hatchery raceways by installing a new low head oxygen (LHO) system complete with power back-up.

Engineers Estimate: \$ 400,000.00

It is the responsibility of the bidders to download any addendum as needed from DGS website address stated above.

Pursuant to Section 1770 of the Labor Code, the Department of Industrial Relations has ascertained the general prevailing wage rates to be as listed in the Prevailing Wage Data Base, located at www.dir.ca.gov, or is available for inspection by interested parties at the address shown above.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 10115 et seq., State law requires that contracts have a participation goal of 3% for Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE's) for all contracts of \$10,000 or more. Bids will only be

accepted from those bidders who certify that they have achieved the goal as outlined in the instructions with the bid forms.

To qualify for the DVBE Incentive Preference, the bidder must achieve a minimum DVBE participation goal of 3%.

The projects bid award is subject to the Small Business Procurement and Contract Act five (5) percent bid preference rules.

A bidder's bond of at least 10% of the bid amount shall be submitted with bids of \$5,000 and over.

For bid awards of \$5,000 and over; a 100% performance bond and 100% payment bond is required.

Work under this agreement also consists of providing pre-construction services for schematic design and design development through bidding, construction management / administration services for the construction to include structural repairs, access pathway at Level 5 and a new elevator.
